<u>York College Report on Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants –</u> August 18, 2021

- 1. York College is pleased to report that we are participating in the CARES, CRRSAA and ARP Acts established by Congress. We have signed and returned the Department of Education's Certification and Agreement that we intend to use the applicable amount of the funds received under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The total grants from the Department of Education for HEERF Funds to York College is \$2,554,447 and of that amount at least \$1,086,783 will be available for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 3. York College has already distributed \$744,148 to students eligible for these grants.
- 4. York College has 460 students who are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a) (4) programs.
- 5. 460 students have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant under CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.
- 6. York College determined that all eligible students needed Emergency Grants for food costs during the Spring of 2020 and we estimated the food costs at \$100 per week for six weeks. Each student then received a grant of \$600. Additionally, \$500 grants to travel back to classes were issued to students in the summer of 2020 based upon their need. Grants between \$500 and \$5,250 were awarded to students who had the greatest financial need for the 2020-2021 academic year. Grants of \$1,000 to \$2,000 were awarded to students in the summer of 2021 who applied for assistance with loss of family income.
- 7. York College is currently assessing student needs and situations and will respond with additional grants as warranted.
