Departmental Scholarship (2009/2010)

Per the 2009/2010 Scholarship Policy; Academic departments can issue a minimum of 5 (or 10% of those students majoring in their field of study) ***“Departmental Scholarships”*** to new prospective students. These scholarships are worth up to \$2,000 each and are for the **first year only** (stacking policies will apply). Note: This award will be issued by the department the student is majoring in not from the department where he/she holds their minor or endorsement.

“Departmental Scholarships” can be awarded to freshman and transfer students.

The intention of these ***“Departmental Scholarships”*** is to award students who are enrolling into a specific program, and to create a unique connection between the student and the faculty member.

QUALIFICATIONS:

In order for the ***“Departmental Scholarships”*** to be awarded the student must:

- Be a **full-time** student.
- **Submit an Application by June 1st** to the Department in which they will major. Grants can be awarded as soon as the Application is submitted or as late as June 15th. If Departmental Grant funds are still available after June 15th then new prospective students will be encouraged to apply.
- Be approved by a faculty member in the department, based on responses to the recommended application or an application form created by the department.
- To apply students must **have a minimum entering CUM GPA of 2.5, or an ACT of 20 or SAT of 950/1410.**

NOTE: Double-majors may not receive two ***“Departmental Scholarships”***.
