

Founders Scholarship

This scholarship opportunity is available to **first-time** students from the Churches of Christ and the Christian Church. The scholarship is a 50% off tuition scholarship for prospective students who meet specific criteria. The Founders Scholarship aims to support active members of the Church of Christ and Christian Church.

This scholarship will be renewable each year as long as the student continues to meet the criteria. This scholarship is a non-stackable scholarship opportunity. Prospective students from Churches of Christ and Christian Churches are encouraged to explore the myriad possibilities offered by the Founders Scholarship and the vibrant community at York University.

The criteria for eligibility include:

- Active Membership in Church of Christ or Christian Church: Prospective students should be actively involved in a Church of Christ or Christian Church community.
- First-time, Full-Time (12 credit hours) Seated Undergraduate Student: The scholarship is intended for students who plan to enroll as full-time seated undergraduate students at York University.
- **Residence on Campus**: To qualify for the scholarship, students should commit to living on campus during their academic tenure at York University.
- **Minimum 2.5 GPA**: Recipients must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.5 to remain eligible for the scholarship.
- **Regular Church Attendance**: Students should demonstrate a commitment to their faith by regularly attending church service.
- **Serve as Student Representative**: For special university related events the students receiving this scholarship may be asked to attend events to represent the student body.
